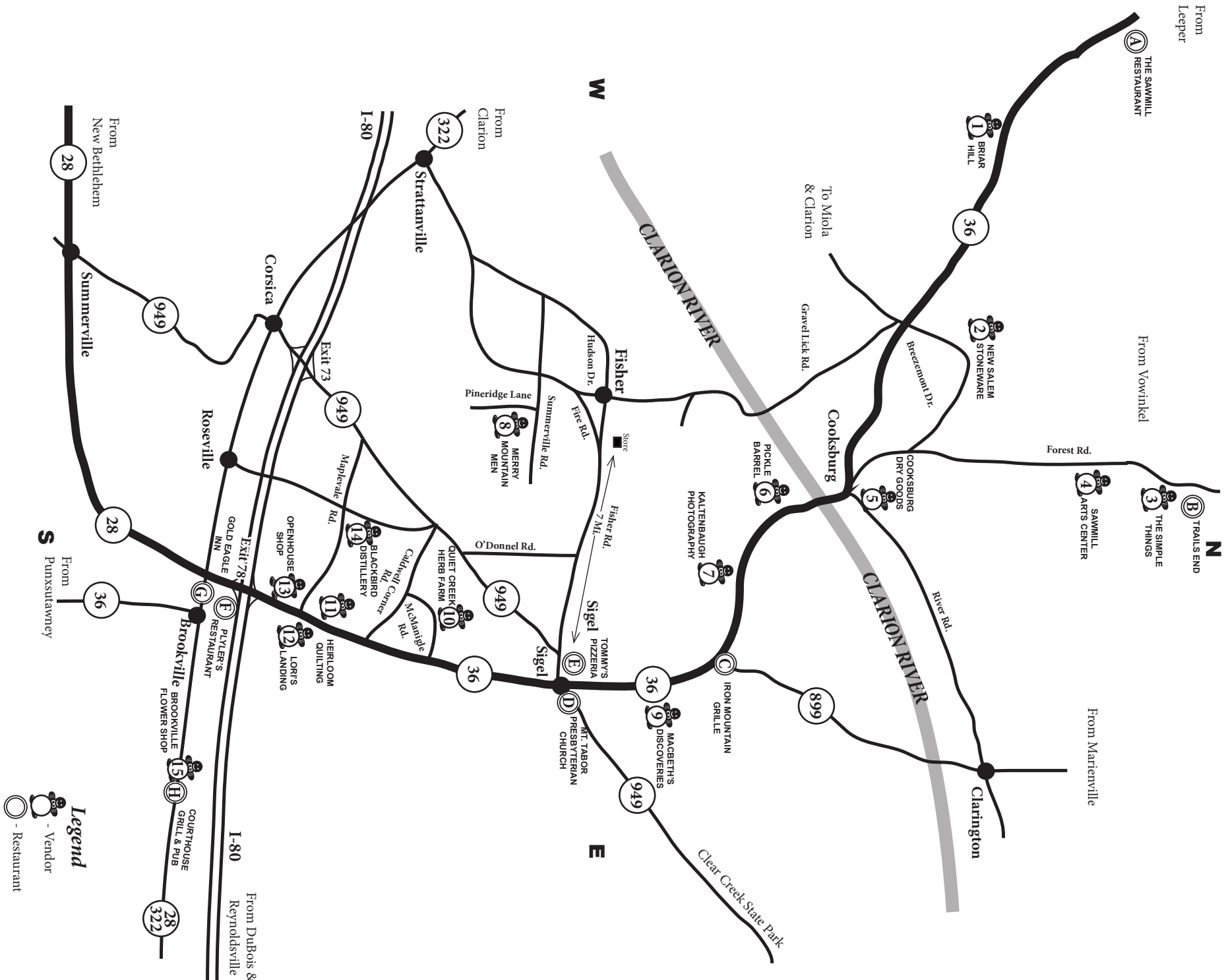


COOK FOREST STATE PARK
